CMH unveils new 3D mammography machine

e have installed a new state-of-the-art mammography machine. The Hologic Selenia 6000 Tomosynthesis Mammography machine is part of the Selenia Dimensions system, and offers better comfort and accuracy for patients.

While conventional mammograms take a single picture of the breast in two directions, digital tomosynthesis (3D) captures multiple X-ray images of each breast from different angles. The breast is positioned in the machine just as it would be in a traditional mammogram, but less pressure is applied due to the ergonomic design.

Powered by C-View[™] software, the Genius 3D MAMMOGRAPHY[™] exam is low-dose and clinically superior. Trina Storck, RN, Director of Imaging Services at CMH, says the new breast cancer screening machine produces a "more in-depth, detailed image."

The system's Genius 3D MAMMOGRAPHY $^{\text{\tiny M}}$ exam provides a 41% increase in invasive breast cancer detection compared to traditional 2D mammography, and up to a 40% decrease in false-positive recalls.

According to CMH radiologist Peggy Rouleau, MD, "Better sensitivity with digital tomosynthesis will decrease patient recalls and lead to more lives saved from screening mammography." The system has truly revolutionized the mammography screening process. CMH


