2013 has been a year of dramatic changes, new relationships and important achievements. Here are some highlights from last year:

COMPLETION OF MAJOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECT. We reached the end of our three-year construction project, the largest construction project in our history. In size and scope, it surpassed the project to build the original hospital in the 1950s.

A NEW PARTNERSHIP. Hospitals in our region have been working on creating a new entity—

tentatively named "Wilderness Health"—to coordinate services, purchasing, contracting and participate in collaborative quality initiatives. We'll share more about this as it evolves.

COMMUNITY HEALTH NEEDS ASSESSMENT. Led by Carlton County Public Health, CMH participated in a community health needs assessment. The assessment concluded that obesity, mental health, and drug use were the top three health priorities for our region; we are determining how CMH can work to address these important health concerns.

CMH LEVEL IV TRAUMA CENTER DESIGNATION. We received our recertification as a Level IV Trauma Center, which represents maintaining and, in our case, exceed-

ing, standards set for facilities within Minnesota to provide coordinated services to those individuals experiencing serious and immediate health events.

NEW DIALYSIS CLINIC COMING SOON.
