


Quick and accurate diagnosis for strep throat and flu



Volunteers at CMH and Sunnyside offer their skills and raise significant funds!

Did you know that about 100 volunteers donate about 5,600 hours each year at CMH? These amazing people serve patient meals, help patients get to the right place for their appointments, cashier in the gift shop, care for the Sunnyside aviary, purchase flowers for monthly birthday parties at Sunnyside and even play the piano! The CMH Auxiliary also raises money for the needs of the hospital and Sunnyside through the hospital gift shop and fundraisers such as Books-R-Fun, the “No-Bake” Sale, Purses for Nurses, sportswear sale, Lights of Love, Christmas boutique and bake sale, used book sale, Annual Garage Sale and Antiquities Photos.

Jennifer Stay is the new coordinator of the Auxiliary. Previously, she worked at Mercy Hospital and served as a coordinator in both hospice and cardiovascular fields and also served as the coordinator of the Carlton County Prenatal Early Childhood Coalition. She works with new and seasoned volunteers, carefully matching the hospital’s and Sunnyside’s needs with the interests and skills of each volunteer.

Jennifer is working to expand and diversify the program, including drawing in more men and young people to volunteer. “If we don’t currently have an opening for your particular talent, we can probably create something,” she said.

DIALYSIS UNIT OPENS AT CMH

Fresenius Kidney Care opened a dialysis unit at CMH earlier this year. Having this medical service in the community means area patients can receive their dialysis treatment closer to home rather than traveling to Duluth.

"It helps patients to see volunteers of all ages, including both men and women," Jennifer said.

And volunteering is fun! As a way of saying "thank you" to volunteers, the Auxiliary provides a complimentary box lunch to all volunteers upon request whenever they are serving, free coffee or tea at the Volunteer Check-in Station, an annual appreciation brunch, and opportunities to attend the Minnesota State Hospital Volunteer Organization's annual conference and the HCAM District B meetings.



Thanks to the CMH Auxiliary, the Speech-Language Pathology Department now has an audiometer. An audiometer is used for hearing tests. By presenting tones from very low to very high pitches at various levels of loudness, a speech/language pathologist can determine if an individual has experienced a hearing loss.

The Auxiliary is guided by a board of directors, headed by President Rosemary Tobin. Over the years, volunteers have raised money for significant purchases, including:

- \$6,000 for artwork in the Riverside Café

- \$36,000 for sterilizer
- \$38,000 for the CMH building project
- Sunnyside Beauty Shop
- Family Room
- Lactation room for visitors and employees

- Audiometer for Speech-Language Pathology Department.
