

Transitional Care provides hospital resources and team-based support so that patients can reach their highest level of independence and function. Patients who recover in a hospital-based Transitional Care program are less likely to be readmitted for an acute hospital stay.

Transitional Care Program



What is Transitional Care?

Transitional Care is a program focused on helping patients transition from a hospital stay to their highest level of independence at home or in another setting.

Examples of patients who may benefit from a Transitional Care program include:

- Patients recovering from complex surgery.
- Patients recovering from a serious illness or injury, such as a heart attack, stroke, traumatic brain injury, and more.
- Patients with a higher risk of developing complications or being readmitted due to one or more comorbidities or chronic disease(s).
- Patients who require specialized treatment, such as wound care, occupational, physical, speech, and respiratory therapies, or intravenous medications.



CMH's private, spacious patient rooms with adjoining private bathrooms make recovery more comfortable.

What to Expect

Our Transitional Care Program is centered on teamwork, communication, and collaboration. Read on to learn more about what to expect when choosing CMH for Transitional Care:

- A personalized plan of care.
- Bedside Rounds that engage the patient, their support system, and care team.
- Hospital level staffing and resources are immediately available in case the patient's condition suddenly changes.
- On average 11.8 day length of stay before being discharged to home or the patient's previous care facility.
- Continuity of caregivers for any follow-up appointments once the patient has returned home.

Is Transitional Care covered by my insurance?

Most Transitional Care provided at CMH is reimbursed under the Medicare Swing Bed program, a Medicare Part A payment program.

- If criteria are met, Medicare Part A will reimburse for up to 100 days of postacute care.
- Some patients may qualify for reimbursement via other programs or payer; if there are questions, please contact our team and we will help determine if your insurance will cover Transitional Care services at CMH.
